The **Guidelines 4 Training** National Conference entitled “PLANNING, IMPLEMENTING AND EVALUATING INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSES” was held on 27-28 May 2022, in Cluj-Napoca, Romania and it was co-organised by ***Bridge Language Study House Association*** and ***QUEST - The Romanian Association for Quality Language Services in Romania*** (EAQUALS Associate Member) within the framework of the Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership entitled “*Guidelines 4 Training*”.
