Following a difficult year and a move to new premises, the entire team at The London School were proud to be able to share our core values through our storytelling project “Say no to hate”.

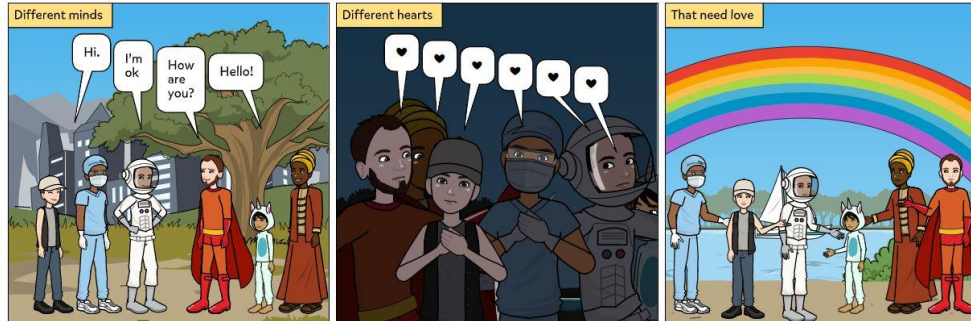
