



# Learning Through Play ; Activities in the Classroom

The following insight into the type of content we include in a particular module is from the Learning Through Play module, as play is a large part of a child's life.

Based on the story of *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* by Eric Carle in the **Food** theme of the EYE curriculum, we introduce the concept of healthy and unhealthy foods. In the module we investigate different aspects of introducing a concept, establishing and practising target language and differentiation for ability or age.

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## **Identifying materials:**

Aim; To identify materials needed to present 'Healthy and Unhealthy Foods' to a group of 3-5 year olds.

#### Introducing a concept:

**Aim;** To discuss how the concept of healthy/unhealthy foods might be introduced to this age group and observe different methods of presentation

#### Choosing and Grading Presentation Language;

Aim; To identify the language to be used in the presentation stage, and how to grade for older, younger, more or less advanced students

## Practising Target Language;

Aim; To identify age-appropriate expectations of target language and set up practice play opportunities

## Incorporating Practice into Play;

Aim; Identifying and providing different play opportunities that allow sts to practice target language

## Challenge; Extending the age range;

Aim; To identify how an activity can be differentiated or changed to suit a different age range
